Pastor's Message

Nelson Diocese priests have been immersed in Clergy Study Week including our own Fr. Obi, who has granted me (Doris Bregolisse - Bulletin Coordinator) the grace to write here today so he can focus on his studies.

It dawned on me that instead, Fr. Obi could have employed Artificial Intelligence (AI) to write for him, as many people do these days. Or for that matter, what's stopping him from turning to AI for homily ideas when short on inspiration?

What would that even look like, I wonder?

AI is supposed to gather its knowledge of any subject from sources available on the internet. That alone frightens me, considering intelligence is seemingly lacking on-line these days, especially on the subject of faith, hope and love for God and our neighbours.

I believe it would be a frightful world to live in should everyone give up on developing God's gifts in themselves in favour of letting computers do all the thinking and creating. And we ultimately are only cheating ourselves out of opportunities to learn, develop and discover our talents if we turn to AI. Even opportunities to fail, become resilient and understand compassion could all be lost.

Anyone who has lived long enough knows that God truly does work in mysterious ways. Faith in His plans for us grow stronger with time even when we lose our way. There are no shortcuts to faith as there are no shortcuts in reaching our goals.

We need only look to our local faith leader to understand that God has a plan for all of us if we allow the Holy Spirit to guide us.

Luke Bertolucci - St. Pius X Young Adult Leader - Tells his story (Part 4 of 4)

When I started my practicum at Immac I still wasn't fully sure that this was God's plan. Anxiety will often make you doubt the most obvious things. Yet, when I arrived in the parking lot for the first time, I parked beside the electronic sign in the parking lot. As I looked at it, it said "you are meant to be here" and I had goosebumps all over my body. God lit up a sign for me. To this day I look at the sign every day but I have never seen a message that was even close to that. He put it on someone's heart to put that message on the sign that day. God's ways are above ours and he uses his people to fulfill his plan.

On the last day of my practicum before Christmas break, the teachers took part in a spiritual retreat led by CCO. My friend from Queen's was the one that led it so he asked me to do the first bible reading of the day. The verse was Jeremiah 29:11 "For I know the plans that I have for your life, plans to prosper you and not to harm you. Plans to give you hope and a future." Again, I had goosebumps as this was a verse I would focus on over and over during the covid lockdown when I was feeling anxiety. Another example of God helping a stubborn mule to figure it out.

After that moment I have not looked back. This job has been more than I could ever ask for. I get to teach others about their faith and I even get to teach my other passions like history and writing. Every day I get to spend time with tomorrow's future and it gives me energy.

I would like to leave you with a few key points that you can use in your lives.

- 1) When you are deciding what to do with your future look at what makes you happy. What excites you? What gives you energy? If you are going to work 40 hours a week it had better be something that you enjoy. Never do something for just the paycheque or the prestige.
- 2) Pray during covid I was still not sure about my future. But rather than stewing in my own anxiety, I brought it to God. Many of you might not know how to pray and that's ok because I didn't either. Start by sitting or laying in silence for a few moments because that is where you will hear him. From there, talk to him. He created you and he wants to hear you. He can handle your frustration and your pain. He will not let you down.
- 3) Similar to point number 2 ask God what his plan for your life is. He knows us better than we know ourselves and his plan is where you will be happiest. It can be scary, but he wants you to surrender it to him. Some of you might have a religious calling, and that is beautiful. It was not meant for me, but I only truly knew that by bringing it to him. And if I did have that beautiful calling to the priesthood I would have accepted, and it would have been where I was most fulfilled. So simply ask him and leave it with him.
- 4) Don't just think about the future all of the time. Enjoy the present moment because you will never get to live it again. Take some time to appreciate where you are at and where you have come from.

I can promise you that if you do these points, you will be happier, more at peace, and more importantly, holier.
