#### **World Mission Sunday**

This Sunday, we celebrate World Mission. St. Terese of Lisieux wanted to be a missionary, to travel round the world to evangelize, but she couldn't. She was in the monastery and eventually became sick. At last, she said, "I have found my vocation in the heart of the Church; my vocation is to love." She truly was a missionary of love.

Some give to the mission by going, some go on mission by giving. This Sunday we are invited to pray for the missionary work of the Church, that the Church may continue to evangelize, to bring the good news of Jesus to the ends of the earth.

At the initiative of Pope Pius XI in 1926, the second last Sunday in October became known as World Mission Sunday. Catholics throughout the world are invited to pray for and give to the missions. The collection this Sunday is organized by the Pontifical Missions Society. The funds collected assist some 1,250 mission dioceses. We are all encouraged to promote missionary vocations and to collaborate spiritually and materially in the Church's mission work.
