Pastor's Message

Advent - The Yearning and Longing of our Hearts

I was at Apex this week. It looked like winter wonderland. It was a reminder to me that Christmas is on the horizon.

How shall we prepare for the coming of Jesus this Christmas? There is no other way other than the way of love. As Martin Luther King said, "When we discover the power of love, we shall make this old world a new world." Let us begin with our family. Let us forgive. Let old resentments go. The Holy Spirit can help us to do this. On our own, it can be difficult.

One of my favourite Advent song is 'O Come O Come Emmanuel.' I found myself singing it already this week. The song evokes in us a longing, a yearning for a Messiah, for hope, for meaning, for that which will last. As we sing it during this Advent, may it help to give expression to the deep longings of our heart.

Advent is a time of pilgrimage: an interior journey that we make with Mary, Joseph and John the Baptist. We are heading to the manger. Dorothy Day once spoke of the manger in a beautiful way. She said, "I'm so glad Jesus was born in a manger. Because my soul is so much like a manger. It's poor and in unsatisfactory condition - yet I believe if Jesus can be born in a manger, maybe he can also be born in me."

As we prepare for Christmas: the beautiful lights and decorations, the shopping and baking, May the manger of our hearts be also prepared so that at Christmas, we can give to Jesus a new heart as we too receive Him anew on Christmas Day.

How can we have a grace-filled Advent as we prepare for Christmas? Here are 10 suggestions:

- 1. Take inventory of life: where am I today in my relationship with Jesus?
- 2. Prepare for our Parish Christmas Confessions which is on Monday, December 16 at 5.30pm.
- 3. A resolution to begin again
- 4. Keep awake through prayer: rediscovering Holy Mass. Maybe attend one more Mass during the week and pray for your family that this year at Christmas, you may be united and be a blessing to everyone.

- 9. Pray together as family.
- 10. Driving and in the grocery store: Words of blessing to the driver before and behind you; same thing as you pay for your groceries, pray for the person before and behind you.




