The Secret of True Joy

Rejoice Always Pray Without Ceasing

This Sunday is called Gaudate Sunday, that is, Sunday of rejoicing. We are more than half way to Christmas and we are invited to rejoice because Jesus is near.

- 1. True joy is a gift. It is not determined by the changing circumstances of life but is a gift from the One who does not change: my Father in heaven. I can rejoice always when I place myself beneath the gaze of my Father who loves me.
- 2. True joy is found in my identity. I am not defined by my sins but by the love of my Father.
- 3. True joy is in my worth. What is my worth? 'Your worth is not measured by what you do; you are worth the death of the Son of God.'
- 4. True joy is in the GIFT: I rejoice because the Father has sent His Son His greatest gift to me: Jesus. He comes to me as a Baby: to hold. In turn this Christmas, as we exchange gifts with loved ones, what gift do I give to God? He doesn't want gold but something more precious than gold: my heart, my soul, my life, my all.

Confession is a time to:

- Give to God the gift of my soul.
- Allow Jesus to love me.
- Remember that I am defined not by my sins but by the love of God.
- Reclaim my identity as the beloved of the Father.
- Allow Jesus to heal any wounds in my heart and soul.
- Lay at his feet my struggles, weakness, inadequacies and sin.
- Begin again.
- Receive the strength to make love the way when we gather as family this Christmas.
- Receive the strength to be an intentional disciple of Jesus.

A good Confession ends with great rejoicing as the Father Himself says: 'Let us celebrate because my child is home.'
