October - Special Month dedicated to our Lady and Rosary

Pope Francis Announcement and Invitation

Pope Francis has announced a Day of Fasting and Prayer for World Peace on October 7th, the first anniversary of the terrorist attack perpetrated by Hamas in Israel. He also announced that on October 6th, he would go to the Church of our Lady of Major (Santa Maria Maggiore) to pray the Rosary and ask for the gift of peace in the world. The Holy Father is asking us to join him in this.

What shall we do in our parish Sunday, October 6th

The Knights of Columbus of our parish has already planned to have a Parish Family Rosary on Sunday, October 6th at 4:00 pm followed by food and fellowship. It'll be a multilingual rosary. War affects all of us - people of every race, tongue and nation. Please come join us as we continue to pray and show solidarity with our Ukranian neighbours.

Monday, October 7th - Feast of our Lady of the Rosary

On this day, the Church commemorates the victory Christians won against the enemies. They won this victory by saying the Rosary. The Rosary was their armour. There are many evils that beset us today. Come join us for Rosary and Mass on Monday, October 7th at 9:00 am to celebrate and to pray. Rosary will start at 8:30 am.

Friday, October 4th - Feast of St. Francis

There will be a blessing of animals at 5:30 pm. Bring your dogs and cats and any other pet you have for a blessing. We just have to warn the cats and dogs that there's no fighting in the Church. The blessing will be done in front of the Church.

We will say the Rosary 30 minutes before all the Masses. The children from our Rosary club will lead the Rosary in different languages before the 11:00 am Mass.

To all our donors, the 2024 bazaar would not have been possible without you. We are immensely grateful.



SPECIAL COLLECTION FOR SETON HOUSE


On October 12th and 13th there will be a special **second collection** in support of Seton House in all parishes in the diocese.

Are you singed up and signed in!?

Formed is a faith-based, on-line service, offered through the St. Augustine Institute, that gives us access to educational and entertainment material of all kinds, for all ages, including educational programs, bible studies, movies, books, audio recordings, sacramental preparation and content appropriate for families.

This is the second year that a FORMED subscription is being provided to all parishioner through the support of the parish and the St. Pius X Catholic Women's League.

As members of our parish, you are invited to access this resource at <u>no charge to you</u>. We will be using some of this content in some of our parish groups and activities, but we encourage you to use it at home as well. We will be posting a monthly suggestion in the bulletin to help familiarize parishioners with Formed's offerings.

Follow these steps to register for the first time:

- 1. Go to www.signup.formed.org
- 2. Enter "St. Pius X Parish Kelowna"
- 3. Click "Next"
- 4. Enter your name and email

Once registered:

- 1. Go to www.formed.org
- 2. Click "SIGN IN" (Top right corner)
- 3. Type in your email address and follow the prompts (you will need to access your email to use Formed)
- *Stay logged in and get the Formed App on Roku and Apple TV.
